Schedule Usage ApprovedCourseMeeting Periods

I. POLICY

- A. Lamar University(LU) provides a defined set of courseneeting periods for face-classes. All full-term and 8 week, undergraduated cture classes neeting between 800am and 3:50m must utilize these meeting times when scheduling course, exceptions to this policy must be approved by the Dean and the Business Manager the College offering the course.
- B. Any departments utilizing single meeting times should offer a corresponding course or courses during the same meeting time on the other days of the meeting pattern.
- C. Non-lecture courses (lab, individual study, practicum, etc.) must utilize the start time of approved meeting times, except for gduate and doctoral courses, cours arting before 800 am or after 3:50 pm, Studio Arts cours bursing Clinicals, and similar nelecture courses. Exception to this must be approved by the Dean and the siness Manager of the College offering the course

II. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

- A. Following a standard pattern of meeting times should reduce scheduling difficulties caused by overlapping courses his should allow students greater freedom in selecting a class schedule that allows the maximum desired courseload.
- B. This policy falls under the authority of **al**pplicable federal, state, and exas State University System (TSUS) statutes, rules, and regulations, including ot limited to the TSUS Rules & Regulations Texas Education Codlette 3, Higher Educational Texas Administrative Code, Title 19, Education.
